

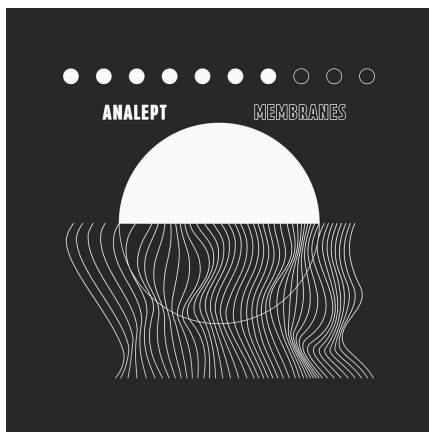
Artist Name/Band Name: Analept



Analept is a Belgian producer deeply influenced by his nostalgic teenage love for the electronic music era of the mid-90s. He began making music during the same period using a very rudimentary two-track software editor and a friend's extensive collection of jazz, funk, and Latin records. Since then, he has developed a penchant for complex designs and simple melodies based on a hardware workflow. His music can be described as a puzzle made up of precise drum programming and modular arpeggiators, all enveloped by various discrete noises, strings, and pads.

2025 marks 2 new additions to his digital and physical catalog with the support of ECU.

'Membranes' is a precursor to the much-anticipated album 'Montage,' which promises a collection of elegant, well-balanced tunes inspired by the iconic electronics of the 90s. This track is a masterful blend of bleak and melancholic melodies that resonate deeply, showcasing Analept's unique ability to transform electronic glitches into profoundly moving music.

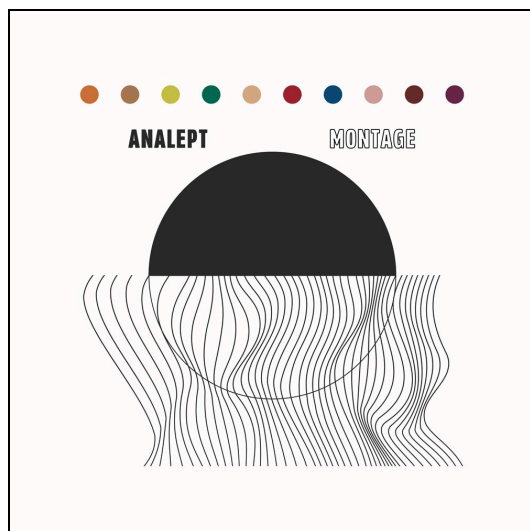
